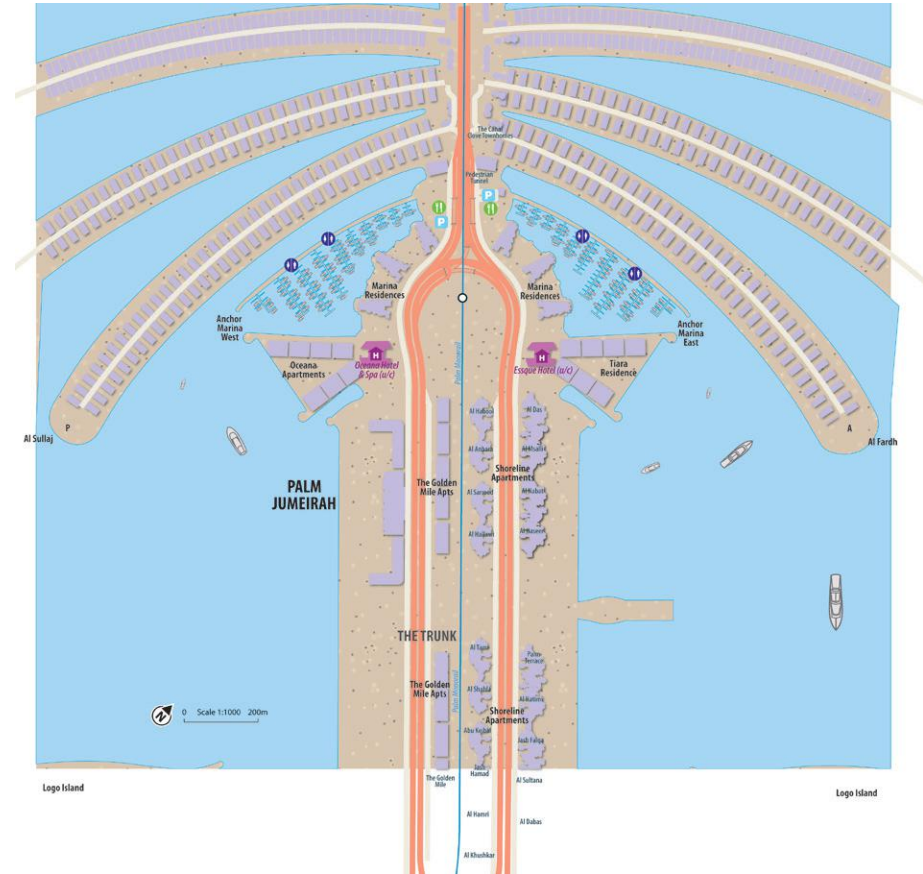

Requirements for getting sail permission

All vessels must attain permission from the Maritime Authority to sail in Dubai waters.

In order to attain permission, all applicants must fill the request-for-permission form and submit all the below mentioned documents:

- Certificate of Registry issued by the Flag state
- Valid Navigation License issued by the flag state or Valid Certificate of Class issued by Classification Society
- Insurance Policy / P&I – Coverage of UAE Waters + Wreck Removal for the period of visit
- Crew list which shall not fall below minimum of 2 crews as per the national legislations
- Berth agreement with Marina / DMCA Long stay permit / letter of maintenance workshops
- Customs Clearance & Immigration documents
- A proof of local shipping agent in the Emirates

Expiry of permit

The permit is valid for six months and it is renewable.

Information related to the visiting Marine vessels

All Clubs, dry docks and Maintenance facilities can ask for all relevant information, including the entry and exit dates of the vessel and other related data. All records have to be maintained and should be presented on demand at any time.

Technical requirements for the visiting vessels

- Foreign Visiting Marine Crafts are expected to secure all Permits issued by DMCA prior sailing in Dubai waters by ensuring that:
- The vessel should be equipped with safety, navigational and tele-communication equipments which meet the standards set by the sailing state.
- Validity certificate for fire fighting equipment, safety tools and rescue to be obtained before leaving Dubai.
- Vessels must not to leave marinas, clubs or maintenance workshops until they get permission from authorised bodies.
- The maritime officials are authorised to enter the vessels and perform quality and safety inspections, to ensure the safe sailing of the vessel

FACTS
of DUBAI



Clothing

Summer clothing may be worn for most of the year but the temperature can drop during the winter. At the pool or on the private beaches, swimwear is quite acceptable, but when in the city and public areas, care should be taken not to offend others by wearing clothing that may be considered revealing.



Driving

Cars are left-hand drive and proceed on the right side of the road as they do in Europe. (Note that international driving permits and overseas driving licenses are not valid in private cars in the UAE).



Currency

The UAE Dirham is the official currency (abbreviated as AED or DHS). You are likely to get preferable currency exchange rates at banks and private financial institutions rather than at hotels. Visa and MasterCard credit cards are more widely accepted than American Express or Diner's Club.



Time Zone

Dubai operates on Gulf Standard Time (GST), which is GMT +4. There is no daylight saving.



Climate

It's sunny in Dubai for most of the year and the winter months from December to March are quite pleasant, with short spells of rainfall. It is important to keep well hydrated and protected in the sun at all times.



Language

The national language spoken is Arabic but English is widely used. However Dubai is home to many different nationalities with an array of languages spoken.



Banks

Many International banks are represented by branches in Dubai. Bank hours are subject to the location and branch. Opening hours are usually 8:00am to 3:00pm and as late as 10:00pm in some malls, Monday to Saturday. Will be close from 12.30pm to 2pm on Fridays to observe the prayer break.



Geography

Dubai lies on the Gulf of the northern shore of the Arabian peninsula, bordered by the Emirates of Abu Dhabi, Sharjah, and the Sultanate of Oman. This part of the Arabian desert is sandy rather than gravelly, with majestic dunes and little water other than the Dubai Creek. The Hajar mountains lie to the southeast.



Drinking Water

Tap water is considered safe to drink, however it is common to drink bottled water as these are the procedures for service in hotels and restaurants.



Electricity

The electricity supply in Dubai is 220/240 volts at 50 cycles. U.S or European made appliances may require a transformer and an adaptor.



Photography

There are many great opportunities to take photographs in Dubai, however we do recommend you consider asking for permission before any photography, especially when people are involved.



Medical Care

Medical services in Dubai are of an international standard and are widely available.



Communication

There are many readily available communication methods in Dubai. With international dialling telephones, postal and courier services Dubai is a central hub for global connection. Electronic mail and fax facilities are also widely available.



Visa and Entry Formalities

Citizens of Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries and a number of others specified can enter without a visa. Please be aware of the latest regulations that apply (they do occasionally change) at the website of the General Directorate of Residency and Foreigners Affairs Dubai (<http://www.dnrd.gov.ae>) or with your local UAE embassy or airline.

DOs & DON'Ts
of WATER SAFETY

Water Safety Begins with You



DOs

Take an approved boating safety course

Use enough fuel for the trip

Check the weather, watch for changing water conditions

Inspect your marine craft (battery, lines, fuel, navigation kits, GPS, fire extinguisher, charts, etc.)



Wear your lifejacket!



Come prepared; bring drinking water, sunglasses, sunscreen and safety equipment



Learn and follow the boating "rules of the road"



Always pay attention!



Inspect your marine craft's communications systems



DON'Ts

DON'T ride on the outside of a marine craft (such as bow riding)

DON'T tie up to buoys or markers

DON'T fish within harbors and swimming areas



DON'T ride too closely to other marine crafts and larger vessels. Remember, boats don't have brakes!

DON'T litter

DON'T operate a marine craft near water-front developments
