

Guidelines – Air Receivers





TESTING & CERTICATION

- Every pressure vessel shall be examined by a competent person approved by Ministry of labour & social affairs.
- Testing frequency shall be once in 12 months & certificate shall be obtained.
- It shall be examined by visual examination & hydrostatic or pneumatic test.

GUARDING

- Ensure that proper guards are provided to all the moving parts like fly wheel & belt.
- Replace the guard immediately after completing maintenance work.
- Undertake regular inspections to check the guarding of the machine.

HOSE CONNECTION & USE

- Air lines shall be connected using proper clamps.
- Air lines should be of good approved quality.
- Never use compressed air for cleaning of clothes or body parts.
- Whip checks must be provided to all connections in a compressed air line.
