Subject: Amendment to the Minor Modification Works Circular: Circular-67319/2010/MAS

Trakhees would like to announce that the **definition** of the low height partition which is classified as one of the minor modification exempted works has now been amended. The amended definition is as follows:

• **Low height partitions:**

Dry wall partitions, which are commonly used for constructing interior walls using panels made of gypsum plaster or similar. **The low height partition should not exceed 1.8m in height (from FFL).** Any other partition higher than 1.8m is classified as a full-height partition which needs to be submitted for Trakhees approvals. The proposed partitions shall be placed / constructed so as not to block/obstruct (1) any of the existing smoke detectors & (2) the water spray discharge of sprinkler(s) or distort its originally designed spray pattern.

Your compliance and cooperation will be appreciated as this is to be implemented with immediate effect.
