In the UAE, most of the residents live in flats/apartments where water is being supplied from a water tank. Tenants usually rely on landlords to clean and disinfect the tanks and pipelines on regular basis. However, some landlords often assign an untrained watchman to clean the water storage tanks resulting to contaminated or unsafe waters.

This contaminated water often includes insects, dead rats, metal and other organic litter that can easily spread bacteria and diseases. Water stored for a long time can also encourage growth of mold and bacteria. Furthermore, high levels of metals such as copper, lead, mercury and others can be toxic to human health. Chlorine from natural contamination can also alter the taste and odour of the water, and could be damaging to health.



Landlords, Building/Facility Management, and Owners must clean and disinfect their water storage tanks every 6 months, which is the recommended frequency of cleaning and must be cleaned by a Certified Water Tank Cleaning Company. After cleaning and disinfecting the water storage tank, water sample must be tested for Chemical and Microbiological analysis to ensure that the water is safe from any health risk/ hazards.
