To: All Shipping Lines, Shipping Agents, Ship Owners and Vessel Operators

Subject: Re-inspection of Ships in Port Jebel Ali, Port Rashid and Port Hamriya

Environment, Health and Safety department (EHS) of Ports, Customs and Free Zone Corporation (PCFC) inspects vessel calling its ports for ensuring vessel safety and compliance with all applicable IMO, GCC, Federal ,Local, Port's EHS and other International Rules and Regulations.

Ships which have been inspected by the EHS department and found deficient will be imposed appropriate sanction as per EHS Ports Regulations.

Ships which need to be re-inspected will be levied with a re-inspection fee in accordance with EHS tariff. Hence you are required to ensure that your vessels are maintained in good and sea worthy condition to avoid re-inspection. Furthermore make sure that your vessels are well notified about Port's EHS inspection procedure.

With your co-operation in maintaining a good vessel standard, we hope to keep our ports safe and clean.
