To: All Ship Master, Shipping Lines, Shipping Agents, Ship Owners and Vessel Operators

SUBJECT: <u>Direct Delivery of Cigarettes Gas Lighters IMO Class 2.1, UN 1057 during</u> Summer Season at Dubai Ports

This circular urges the shipping community to comply with the below requirements regarding handling of <u>Gas Lighters IMO Class 2.1, UN 1057</u>.

- 1. Cigarettes Gas Lighters, IMO Class 2.1, U.N. 1057 either shipped in containers or break-bulk for Dubai Importation should now be on direct delivery basis during the entire period of the summer months starting from 01<sup>st</sup> July 2009 till 15<sup>th</sup> September 2009. Except T/S containers which should be in Reefer containers during these period.
- 2. The concerned shipping line agent will be held accountable for any incident, damage or leakage that may occur during the transport of this highly volatile hazardous cargo. Contravention of the above requirements may result to imposition of fines or sanctions against your company.
- 3. All relevant IMDG Code requirements should be strictly followed.

This circular is intended to assist all concerned parties to promote a safer and cleaner working environment.
