

CIRCULAR: EHS/PM/05/12 Dated: 31st October 2012

To: All Third Party Hazmat/Tank Cleaning Service Providers and Other Interested Parties

Subject: EHS Requirements for Hazmat/Tank Cleaning Service Providers

This circular informs all concerned that the following Trakhees-EHS requirements shall be followed by all new companies intending to register with EHS-Trakhees as "Prequalified Third Party Service Provider" for carrying out Hazmat/Tank cleaning operations within PCFC jurisdictions in addition to the existing Prequalification requirements stipulated in the EHS procedure EHS-PMP-05 which can be accessed through the below link:

- 1. Minimum eight operational employees whose basic academic qualification not less than High School Leaving certificate (SSLC/ High School)
- 2. One Safety Officer/Safety Supervisor/Safety Representative whose academic qualification shall be degree in engineering or minimum three year degree in science or three years engineering diploma holder from a recognized university with at least one year experience in safety.
- 3. Supervisor/Foreman at the site shall possess minimum three year degree or three year diploma from a recognized university with at least one year industrial experience in similar activities.
- 4. They(Item no 2 & 3) shall possess professional training in Safety including but not limited to Risk Assessment, IMDG Code, Chemical Safety, Basic Fire fighting etc., from reputed institute.
- 5. The company shall be in existence for minimum one year in UAE
- 6. The company must have experience in minimum six hazmat handling operations prior to apply for Pre-qualification.
- 7. Certificates of Academic qualification are subjected to verification, hence appropriate authentication is required from relevant authorities.
- 8. All personnel engaged in Hazmat operation must be the employee of the approved company and EHS approval is required for engaging subcontracted labours.
- 9. Submission of any forged documents (certificates, qualifications, experience etc.) will lead to disqualification/ban as well as legal action against the company.
- **10.** All existing approved companies need to comply with the above requirements not later than 1st Jan 2013.
