**Subject: Reminder- Implementation of Accreditation Program for Trakhees EHS Port Regulations.** 

This is to remind all Shipping/Line Agents that it is a mandatory requirement to have at least two accredited staff in your team who must have successfully completed the accreditation program in Trakhees-EHS Regulations for Port Operations. This accreditation program was introduced in December 2010 to ensure that all concerned port clients are fully aware of their roles and responsibilities to comply with Occupational Health & Safety and Environmental protection requirements during their direct and indirect involvement in Port Operations. But the records show that some of the clients have not yet completed the accreditation program and unaware of the Port regulatory requirements. Hence you are required to comply with this accreditation requirement by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2012, if not accredited earlier.

Failure to comply with these requirements will result in suspension of all transactions of the company such as approvals for waste disposal, leaking containers, IMDG approval, ship repair etc.,
