



## Preamble

- A) The Environmental Regulations supersede the Environmental Control Rules and Requirements (4<sup>th</sup> Edition, 2005).
- B) The Environmental Regulations detail the Ports, Customs and Free Zone Corporation (PCFC) – Trakhees standards and requirements to protect the environment from industrial, port operation, etc. Trakhees being the regulatory arm of Dubai World have adopted a policy of source control in which operations shall be conducted in an environmentally sound manner.
- C) All Clients are required to adopt and operate clean, modern technologies, efficient use of energy and materials and minimize waste generation by operating Recycle, Reuse and Recovery (RRR) options and the safe and responsible disposal of any residual wastes. An effective balance has to be struck between the industry and environment which will not only provide the necessary measure to protect the environment, but will also not act as a deterrent to industrial growth and hence achieve the sustainable development.
