1. Purpose

- (i) The safety and integrity of any lifting appliances/equipment is essential to carryout safe operations,
- (ii) Road Safety is of critical importance and especially when it concerns transport of dangerous goods.

In the same regard, to enable the Entry and Safe operation of Mobile Crane/Lifting Equipment Bulk Gases and Gas Cylinder Vehicles & Industrial Fuel Supply Tanker in PCFC jurisdictional areas, an Entry Permit is required to be obtained from TRAKHEES. All such Cranes/Lifting Equipment, Vehicles & Tankers operating without a valid Permit are deemed unauthorized and the users are liable for penalties/sanctions under Trakhees Regulations.

2. Scope

Applicable to all Mobile Cranes/Lifting Equipment, Vehicle carrying Bulk Gases and Gas Cylinders & Industrial Fuel Supply Tanker, entering in PCFC Jurisdictional areas

JAFZA – Jebel Ali Free Zone Authority



4. Procedure

4.1 Payment: The Entry Permit process fee as mentioned in the Service Fee column below, shall be paid/deposited in advance, prior to the application submission. Payments can be done through Online and/or Mobile application, or direct bank transfer to Trakhees Bank account.

4.2 Submission of Application: The 3rd Party/Service Provider Company shall submit the application through Trakhees Online System two (02) Working Days before the proposed entry. The submission should contain the following required copies of the documents:

4.2.1 Attachment for Mobile Crane/Lifting Equipment:

- 4.2.1.2 Mobile Crane Registration
- 4.2.1.3 Crane Operators Driving License
- 4.2.1.4 Test Certificate obtained from Trakhees Approved 3rd Party companies

- 4.2.2.1 Trade License of Company
- 4.2.2.2 Vehicle & Trailer Registration
- 4.2.2.3 Drivers License
- 4.2.2.4 Test Certificate obtained from Approved 3rd Party companies (Bulk Tanker)
- 4.2.3.5 DCD Approval/Hazmat Permit for Driver & Helper
- 4.2.3.6 DCD Approval for Vehicle & Trailer

4.4 Review of Documents: Applications submitted for “Mobile Crane/Lifting Equipment Entry Permit / Bulk Gases & Gas Cylinder Vehicle Entry permit / Industrial Fuel Supply Tanker Entry Permit, shall be reviewed subsequently within two(2) Working days. Upon satisfactory compliance with the process requirements, the Entry permit will be issued and made available in Online for download.

4.5 Inspection/Approval: The Mobile Crane/Lifting Equipment / Bulk Gases & Gas Cylinders vehicle / Industrial Fuel Supply Tanker may be required to be presented for Inspection at Trakhees Office or in the site for exceptional cases, prior to issuance of the Permit. The Crane/Equipment/Vehicle/Tanker may also be Randomly Inspected in working/service areas by Officers.

4.6 Fuel Depot: For Industrial Fuel Supply Tanker Applications, the Client shall have a proper Fuel Depot facility/premise, with Tanks, Dispensing Units, Process lines, etc. installed fulfilling the requirements of Dubai Civil Defence (DCD).

6. Service Fees:

All payments shall be done in advance. Payments can be done through Online and/or Mobile Application, or Direct Bank Transfer to Trakhees Bank account prior to submission of application through online.
